

## **Granite Allotment Liquidambar Lane Woden Cemetery Information Sheet**

A granite allotment in Liquidambar Lane is an ashes grave which comprises a granite receptacle which is sealed with the memorial plaque.

The cost of the memorial plaque is included in the allotment purchase price, as is the interment of the ashes, a one off maintenance fee (in perpetuity) and the allotment fee. In accordance with Canberra Cemeteries policy, only one set of ashes can be interred in a granite allotment.

Prior to the ashes interment taking place, Canberra Cemeteries requires the completed Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment form, a copy of the cremation certificate and the memorial plaque to be ready in advance of the interment, as the plaque will be used to seal the receptacle once the ashes have been placed inside the receptacle.

Ashes interments can take place 7 days of the week. Weekend interments can occur if the family is prepared to bring the ashes with them, place the ashes and then seal the receptacle with the plaque. If required, a staff member may be available to assist with placement of ashes for bookings between 9.00am and 3.30pm on weekdays. If the family does not want to be present for the ashes interment, Canberra Cemeteries will do the interment on their behalf and notify the family afterwards.

Upon receiving the completed plaque application form, Canberra Cemeteries will request the plaque proof, which is then sent to the Exclusive Rights Holder (ERH)\* for review. The plaque proof will need to be approved and returned to Canberra Cemeteries before the plaque can be ordered. The approximate timeframe for delivery is 4-6 weeks from the day the plaque is ordered. A ceramic photo can be placed on the plaque and it is preferable that the ceramic photo is organised at the time of the plaque proof so that provision is made in the plaque text to accommodate the ceramic photo. There is an additional cost for a ceramic photo.

Fresh flowers only are permitted at the grave.

Canberra Cemeteries will not be responsible for any personal, valuable or sentimental items that are placed on the grave.

*\*The Exclusive Rights Holder of the Allotment is the person who completes the Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment form prior to the burial occurring or at the time of the allotment purchase. They become the sole authority on any future matters regarding the allotment, including burials and memorialization.*
