

## Wall of Remembrance Allotment Gungahlin Cemetery Information Sheet

A wall of remembrance allotment is an ashes grave located in an impressive undercover structure and features a metallic blue memorial plaque installed on a granite wall. The ashes can be interred in the underground vault or behind the plaque. Please note, there is an additional cost to have the ashes interred behind the plaque.

The cost of the memorial plaque is included in the allotment purchase price, as is the interment of the ashes in the underground vault, a one off maintenance fee (in perpetuity) and the allotment fee. In accordance with Canberra Cemeteries policy, only one set of ashes can be interred in a wall of remembrance allotment.

Prior to the ashes interment taking place, Canberra Cemeteries requires the completed Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment form and a copy of the cremation certificate.

Ashes interments can take place Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 3:30pm. If the family does not want to be present during the ashes interment, Canberra Cemeteries will do the interment on their behalf and the family will be notified afterwards.

Most families prefer to make arrangements for the interment of the ashes after the memorial plaque has been installed. You may, if you prefer, make the booking at any time before the memorial plaque has been installed.

Upon receiving the completed plaque application form, Canberra Cemeteries will request the plaque proof, which is then sent to the Exclusive Rights Holder (ERH)\* for review. The plaque proof will need to be approved and returned to Canberra Cemeteries before the plaque can be ordered. The approximate timeframe for delivery and installation is 4-6 weeks from the day the plaque is ordered. The ERH will be notified when the plaque has been installed.

Canberra Cemeteries will not be responsible for any personal, valuable or sentimental items that are placed at the grave.

*\*The Exclusive Rights Holder of the Allotment is the person who completes the Application for Exclusive Right of Allotment form prior to the burial occurring or at the time of the allotment purchase. They become the sole authority on any future matters regarding the allotment, including burials and memorialization.*
